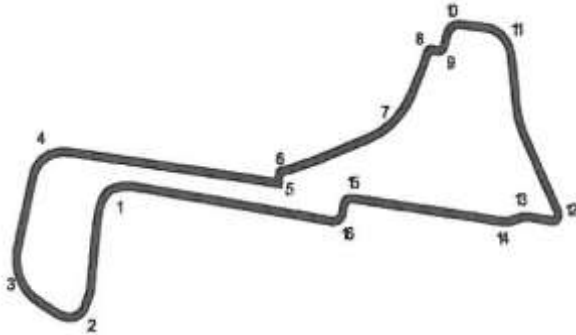

Paddock

Installation from Friday 7th November 13h00.

Passes

The paddock entrance is free.

Each car entered receives :

10 pitlane bracelets, 1 paddock pass for service vehicle, 3 paddock passes for cars.

Team trucks don't need a paddock pass.

Tickets can be collected : Friday 7th November from 16.00-19.00 in the Control Tower (reception desk) and Saturday 8th November in the Welcome Center from 06.30-14.00.

Boxes

Price : € 75,00 per box.

For the key of the box a deposit of € 100 is asked.

The area behind the box (5 m x20 m) is only destined for sportive purposes and therefore it may not be used for hospitality tents or hospitality busses. Any breach will be fined : € 65,00/m².

Each commercial or promotional activity must be submitted to VZW Terlamen for approval in written.

Fuel

Till the start of the race at the fuel station in paddock 4 (with credit cards) and during the race at the installation at the beginning of the pitlane.

For the use of fuel an advance of **€ 400,00** must be paid Friday in the Control Tower or Saturday in the Welcome Center. The final settlement will be made in the week following the race.

Washing of racecars

It is ok to wash them in the paddock.

Leaving Paddock

Dismantling is only allowed after the end of the race. Teams who have to dismantle after abandon of the race have to require a permission by the clerk of the course. Breaking this rule will be punished (by the organizers).

Drivers briefing

Saturday 8th November at 09h00 in the Congress Center, paddock zone 2, green stairs.

Transponder

Transponders to be used must be AMB TranX Pro or AMB TranX 260. If you do not have these please ask one at the secretariat at the Tower Friday from 13h00 – 19h00 & Saturday from 06h30 – 23h00. They are free of charge. Transponders must be returned Saturday after the race at 22h45 at the latest to the secretariat Control Tower.

Chasubles / bracelets

A € 100 deposit must be paid for 3 orange chasubles to get access to the signalisation zone.

Another € 100 deposit must be paid for 6 green bracelets to get access to the working zone.

Chasubles and bracelets are available at the Control Tower.

The deposit will be refunded if the chasubles/bracelets are returned in good condition to the race secretariat, at the latest one hour after the end of the race.
